Ordinance Millage Rate 2018: Councilman Andrews stated the credit does not belong to him but the budget committee and department heads. Commend them all for their hard work, keeping us fiscally responsible. City Accountant Harrison recommending to adopt Ordinance setting millage rate for 2018 at 11.971 and sign the form 32.1. Motion made by Councilman Andrews to adopt; seconded by Councilman Evans. Councilman Wright stated that the city is doing some excellent things with center park and events, dirt is moving, minimal investment. We have been able to do this tremendously responsibility.
