Middle Georgia Regional Commission-Approval Contract & Designation of Signatory: Director of Marketing & Economic Development Hogan provided a copy of contract to Council for review. Seeking approval to move forward and execute contract. Mrs. Hogan reported that this is not a budgeted item. Mayor Pro Tem/ Councilman Evans reminded everyone that this was included in the budget last FY 2017, however was not included in FY2018. Councilman Armijo asked how will this be paid? City Accountant Harrison stated there is \$50,000 in General Fund contingency. Councilman Armijo made motion to approve. City Attorney Tydings informed all that she has reviewed agreement and no issues. Mayor Harley would be the signatory if approved and could sign on Thursday. Director of Marketing/ Economic Development Hogan recognized Michelle Grembowski with RDC, who chairs study. Mrs. Grembowski stated that part of this would be with her staff, extensive survey done in Perry they won a national award.
