

Special Council Meeting

June 28, 2017

Meeting called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Evans at 4:30pm.

Present were Mayor Pro Tem Micheal Evans, Councilman Cameron W. Andrews, Councilman Randall Wright, Councilman Edward D. Armijo and City Attorney Tydings. Absent-Mayor Harley.

Sanitation Contract Assignment -Ryland Environmental: Councilman Armijo made motion to accept as written; seconded by Councilman Andrews. City Attorney Tydings pointed out the effective date contract assignment will become on or before August 1, 2017 and all (3) parties execute contract. Motion carried.

Discussion July 3, 2017 City Hall Office Hours: Councilman Andrews recommended that all employees have off July 3 in conjunction with July 4. Would be a morale booster and a good gesture. Councilman Evans agrees with comments. Motion made by Councilman Andrews to close city hall on Monday July 3, 2017; seconded by Councilman Armijo. Councilman Armijo wanted to know how many days we already have for paid holidays. City Attorney Tydings confirmed 12 days. Councilman Evans stated that Christmas and New Year's will fall on Monday. Councilman Wright doesn't support voting to be off July 3. Councilman Armijo asked why Councilman Andrews again why he recommends closing city hall July 3. Councilman Andrews reiterates prior comments. Mayor Pro Tem Evans calls for vote. Councilman Andrews and Mayor Pro Tem Evans vote in favor. Councilman Wright and Councilman Armijo oppose. Motion fails, tie vote.
