<u>Approval of Award/Contract/Designation of Funding Source - 2017 Centerville LMIG SEC Project #1041</u>: Director of Operations Brumfield seeking approval for contract which includes Hickory Glen, Brantley Rd paving; to designate a funding source for the City's portion (\$

51,188.00 to be paid out of 2012 SPLOST funds). Motion to approve made by Councilman Wright; seconded by Councilman Evans. Motion carried. Councilman Wright amended motion to include authorization, designating Mayor Harley to sign the contract on behalf of the City when the contract is ready; seconded by Councilman Evans. Motion carried.

Every Day Heroes Event/Safe Kids Day: Police Chief Hadden reported that the event on Facebook has received over 300 interactions and we have notified media outlets (41NBC, 13WMAZ, Houston Home Journal, Macon Telegraph) and the Robins Regional Chamber).
