Service Delivery Strategy Update - Greg Boike, Middle Georgia Regional Commission: Mayor Pro Tem/ Councilman Andrews recognized Greg Boike. Mr. Boike informed everyone that every county within the State of Georgia adopt a Service Delivery Strategy which identifies the methods, funding sources, service provider, and geographic service area of each public service activity provided within the county. The City of Perry has requested updates to the Service Delivery Strategy (SDS) to be officially adopted and verified by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs by April 1, 2019 in support of a grant application. Inclusion of housing of service-rehab of homes and need funding to do repairs and since it is state funding has to be included in the SDS.

Mrs. Tydings reported that Centerville has been designated a GICH committee (Georgia Initiative for Community Housing. Mayor Pro Tem / Councilman Andrews entertained motion to adopt. Motion made by Councilman Evans to adopt resolution as written; seconded by Councilman Armijo. Motion carried. See Resolution 2019-1.
