COVID-19 Expansion of Services Plan-Amended/Notice of Increased Health and Safety Measures

In accordance with Chief Justice Harold Melton's "Declaration of Statewide Judicial Emergency" and all Extending Orders, increased health and safety measures have been taken by this court to limit the transmission of Covid-19. Consistent with best practices and guidelines developed by the Georgia Council of Municipal Court Judges, the following measures must be adhered to.

Before entering the building:

- Temperature screening will be conducted. If your temperature is 100.4 or higher, access to the building will be denied.
- A series of questions will be asked. If you answer "yes" to any of the questions, access to the building will be denied.
- A mask or face covering is required at all times. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided for you.

For your protection:

- Hand sanitizing stations are available throughout the building. We encourage frequent hand washing and sanitation.
- Only 1 person is allowed in any restroom at one time. Disinfecting and personal sanitizing supplies are provided.
- A 6-foot distance from other people must be maintained at all times.
- Areas of public access are sanitized prior to and following contact.

Additional Courtroom measures:

- Only 1 Defendant, Defendant's Attorney (if applicable), and/or 1 parent/guardian (if defendant is under 21) will be allowed in the courtroom at one time.
- All attendees must wait in a vehicle or other designated area following screening. Court personnel will make contact and direct further action.

Reasonable and Necessary Accommodation provided for the following:

- You are currently infected with Covid-19 or in quarantine due to an exposure to Covid-19.
- You are sick or experiencing symptoms of Covid-19.
- You are a member of an immune-compromised or medically fragile population (or living in a household with someone who is immune-compromised or medically fragile).
- You are over 65.
- You have small children but have no childcare due to Covid-19.
- You require a foreign language interpreter.

- Within 10 days of receiving citation.
- Immediately upon notification of infection, illness, quarantine, or lack of childcare due to Covid-19.
