

Public Meeting

The City of Centerville hereby gives notice that a public meeting will be held to discuss the sanitary sewer trunk main extension project funded by Georgia's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF). The meeting will be December 20th, 2022 at 5pm at Centerville City Hall, located at 300 E Church Street, Centerville, Ga 31028.

The proposed project will extend the sanitary sewer line north along the Bay Gall Creek from the end of the existing trunk main to an existing sewer line just south of Dunbar Road. The pipe size of the trunk main would begin as a 16" and progressively enlarge to 24". The benefit of extending the trunk main would allow economic development of approximately 1500 acres along the Bay Gall Creek corridor and land north of Dunbar Road. The anticipated cost of the project is \$3,000,000.

The purposes of the public meeting are to:

1. Inform the public of the need to extend the sanitary sewer trunk line along the Bay Gall Creek.
2. To comply with Section 391-6-.02 of Georgia's Water Quality Control Rules and Regulations.
3. To encourage public involvement in the development of a plan to extend the sanitary sewer truck line.

During the public meeting the City will attempt to identify public preferences or alternatives for sanitary sewer availability in the Bay Gall area. These preferences will be evaluated and included in the City's Preliminary Engineering Report and Environmental Information Planning Document. This document is available for public inspection through the date of the public meeting on the City's website, www.centervillega.org and at the window of the City Clerk's Office at the City Hall Building, 300 E Church Street, Centerville, Ga 31028.

Public participation is considered essential to the selection and development of the final plan to be adopted prior to its approval by the State of Georgia Department of Natural Resources.
