Bulk Waste

- Small items (limit 2 per month), picked up at no charge
- Brown goods – large items such as furniture, mattresses, appliances, AC Units, etc. are \$25 each
- Any extra bags and repeated excess trash will generate a second cart charge.
- Batteries and construction debris will not be picked up at all.
- Only the allotted amount of yard waste will be collected each week.
- Extra charges will be reviewed by the City and work orders generated. This will eliminate the issue of charges being denied and give Code Enforcement information they need if they must prosecute.

Sanitation Guidelines for Residential Customers

Yard Waste and Limbs

- All yard waste and limbs must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your service day. If it is too much to be picked up by the garbage truck, they will be placed on a list and picked up the next day by the limb truck.
- Limbs must be placed at least 2 feet away from cart, trash items, other yard waste, mailbox, fence, ground meters, storm drains, or low hanging limbs if possible.
- Limbs must be no more than 10 feet in length or 4 inches in diameter, and stacked in one pile that is no more than 4 feet wide by 4 feet high by 10 feet long parallel to the street. **ABSOLUTELY** no trash or any other yard waste or debris may be mixed with limbs.
- Yard waste such as leaves, grass clippings, pine straw, pinecones, small twigs, sticks, shrubbery and tree clippings, and other small items must be bagged and sealed or containerized. A maximum of 20 bags of yard waste are allowed per week. Bags must be strong enough not to break when picked up and must not exceed 30 gallons in capacity. Cardboard boxes are NOT authorized containers because they fall apart when wet.
- If you are doing a major yard cleanup, lot clearing, cutting down trees, etc., please call 478-953-3222 in advance. You might need to get a special container.

Household Garbage/Trash and Cart Placement

- Garbage carts are the property of the City of Centerville and must not be painted, abused, or mutilated.
- Carts must be curbside, lid closed, by 6:00 a.m. on your service day. (NOTE: Carts may be placed curbside no sooner than the day prior to service, and moved back behind the building line, in accordance with Chapter 34, Section 34-81(2), no later than the day after collection.) Hours for placement, location and moving back of carts also applies to limbs, bulk items, extra trash/garbage, etc.
- Carts are for household garbage/trash only. This does **NOT** include tires, hazardous waste, paint, gasoline, motor or cooking oil, antifreeze, solvents, tile, concrete, bricks, dirt, batteries, construction material, limbs, cardboard, etc. Items such as ashes, Styrofoam, cat litter/animal waste, packing peanuts, etc. must be bagged and sealed before placing in cart. Raw garbage must be bagged and sealed. Any other items placed in the cart should not hinder the free flow of refuse from the cart when it is emptied.
- Items, with the exception of limbs and bulk waste, placed outside cart must be bagged and sealed or otherwise containerized. The capacity of bags or acceptable containers must not exceed 30 gallons. Cardboard boxes are NOT authorized containers for garbage/trash because they fall apart when wet. If you consistently have excess trash, an additional cart will be supplied at a cost of \$24.00 per month.
- Paints and stains must be solidified by mixing with sand, cat litter, or oil dry per OSHA regulations and placed beside your cart. All antifreeze, oil, (including household oil such as Mazola, Wesson, etc.) and other regulated materials **MUST BE** taken to and disposed of at the Centerville Recycling Center on Carl Vinson Parkway or other authorized recycling facility per OSHA regulations.
- Aerosol cans must be completely empty.
- Items such as mirrors and pictures containing glass must be taped and cross-taped to prevent shattering.
- Cardboard boxes should be flattened, bundled, and taken to Centerville Recycling Center on Carl Vinson Parkway if possible.



Sanitation Guidelines for Residential Customers

Household Garbage/Trash and Cart Placement

- Any items placed curbside outside these guidelines may be subject to an additional charge. They are to be placed curbside in a neat, orderly manner by 6:00 a.m. on your service day. Bulk items (known as Brown Goods) such as furniture, mattresses, and appliances, will be picked up no later than the day after your regular collection day. Any items beyond that are subject to a \$25 fee for each item.
- The following items are excluded from pickup:
 - Construction and Remodeling Materials including, but not limited to:
 - bricks
 - cabinets
 - carpet/pad/tack strips
 - concrete
 - countertops
 - doors
 - drywall
 - fencing
 - flooring
 - gutters
 - lumber
 - plywood
 - posts
 - shingles
 - siding
 - sinks
 - tile
 - toilets
 - windows
 - Antifreeze
 - Batteries
 - Gasoline and Oils, including motor and cooking
 - Toxic and hazardous materials
