### Old Business

Sanitation Contract Amendment Ryland - Additional Route Day (Friday): Councilman Wright recognized Director of Operations Brumfield. Mr. Brumfield informed all that the amendment to the contract includes an additional route day, as follows:

AMENDMENT to RYLAND's provision of curbside collection service for the collection of waste material, including but not limited to household garbage, collected in all covered units located within the municipal boundaries of the CITY:

The Old Stone Crossing Subdivision, Houston Pointe Subdivision, Willow Stone Subdivision, and Grove Landing Subdivision neighborhoods shall, effective October 1, 2024, have a curbside collection day for waste material in all covered units (including but not limited to household garbage) of Friday.

Motion made by Councilman Wright to approve with amendments; seconded by Councilman Bird. Motion carried.
