What can you recycle at the Centerville Recycling Center?

Glass

We Collect Clear, Brown and Blue/
Green Glass when Happy Hour
Containers are available.

Metals

Metals should be clean and be one of
the following:

Ferrous Metals: Contain iron which is
magnetic. Includes food containers,
metal hangers and many appliances
(There is a \$10 donation for each
appliance that contains Freon.)

Non-Ferrous Metals: Non-magnetic
metals include copper tubing,
plumbing materials, electrical wires,
brass keys or fixtures, tin cans,
aluminum bottles, aluminum plates,
aluminum foil, aluminum siding/shed
doors, and lead weights.

Aluminum Drink Cans: Non-magnetic
aluminum drink cans are separated
from other aluminum and includes
beer/soda cans. (Please ensure this
cans are rinsed and dry.)

Paper

The Recycling Center accepts all types of
paper. Please separate in the following
containers:

Newspaper: Newspaper, including glossy
inserts (Please remove from any plastic/
paper bags.)

Office Paper: Junk mail, adding machine
tape, phone messages, colored paper,
envelopes (including those with plastic
windows,) brochures, copy paper, sticky
notes, notebook paper, computer paper
(white/green bar,) and
Shredded paper.

Magazines, Slick Paper, Phone Books:
Magazines (should be shared with friends
before recycling,) Phone books/paper
manuals with glued bindings.

Cardboard

Corrugated Cardboard: moving boxes
(Please break down before recycling,)
cereal boxes, shoe boxes, cellulose
insulation, and brown paper bags (Please
give serviceable brown paper bags to the
operator for recycling to the local Food
Bank.)

Other items that the Recycling Center accepts:

Cooking Oil, Motor Oil and Anti-freeze.
Hearing Aids and Glasses for the Lions
Club.
